

WYOMING RESIDENT VETERANS LIFETIME PERMIT

1. Pursuant to W.S. § 36-4-121(n); any Wyoming resident disabled veteran who receives fifty percent (50%) or more service-connected disability compensation from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs may apply to the Division of Wyoming State Parks and Historic Sites, Concession and Revenue, 2301 Central Avenue, Barrett Bldg. 4th Floor, Cheyenne, WY 82002, for a Lifetime Veteran's Permit which covers all day use and camping fees for all Wyoming State Parks, recreation areas, archaeological and Historic Sites (except for camping at Hot Springs State Park).
2. Wyoming resident veterans may apply for the lifetime permit by mail or in person to the Wyoming State Parks and Historic Sites Headquarters at the above address.
3. The applicant shall submit the following: an application to the Cheyenne Headquarters; proof of Wyoming residency in the form of a Wyoming driver's license; and proof of fifty percent (50%) or more service-connected disability from the Veterans Administration.
4. A Wyoming State Parks and Historic Sites Resident Veterans Lifetime Permit shall be issued to any qualified Wyoming resident veteran who has completed the application process. Only one (1) permit will be issued to any applicant and shall remain valid as long as the holder maintains Wyoming residency. The permit shall be valid for the applicant and for all occupants of the applicant's vehicle.
5. Wyoming resident veterans will be required to show the lifetime permit as well as photo identification to gain access to all Wyoming State Parks and Historic Sites.
6. The lifetime permit shall be displayed so that it is visible in the lower driver's side windshield of the vehicle for the duration of the stay at any Wyoming state park or historic site.
7. In the event of a damaged, lost or stolen permit, contact the Cheyenne headquarters office. For a damaged permit return the permit to the Cheyenne office and a replacement permit will be issued. If lost or stolen, contact the Cheyenne office and the permit will be voided and a new permit issued.
8. A lifetime permit holder may purchase annual permits for vehicles registered to their name or address. These are available at the same rates as are charged for additional annual permits. To purchase, the holder must present their lifetime permit along with the registration of the additional vehicle. Annual permits are only good for the calendar year indicated on the permit sticker.
